We have had a really calm and productive fortnight in school. It was lovely to welcome some new faces to our Stay and Play session on Tuesday. It was a super afternoon with plenty of time to play and chat, a focused activity, and a circle time together. Please do spread the word!

Chestnuts had a fantastic day yesterday learning basic first aid techniques. Although the session linked specifically to *Wild Tribe*, the children gained valuable skills they can use in a wide range of situations.

Catkins have been learning about how Winter turns to Spring this week. We made bird feeders to hang amongst the trees growing in our school field and began to prepare for Spring by sowing some early vegetable seeds to nurture indoors until it is time to plant out. # Acorn/Birch Class Update

This week the children have really enjoyed our new English text, 'Cave Baby.' They have created their own cave paintings, re-told the story with role play and freeze frames. After all the fun they have written very descriptive sentences about the animals in the story! Year 2 have been demonstrating their brilliance using multiples of 10 and 5 in Maths. Year 1 have been exploring numbers and how they can be partitioned. They have demonstrated their discoveries using various methods, (including recording on the table!) On Thursday afternoon it was too wet to go outside for PE so the children had a Yoga session indoors. Everyone has continued to enjoy experimenting with water colour during Art and have produced some very impressive painting. Acorns are learning about Superheroes and made vehicles for the Superheroes who help look after us!



# Chestnut Class Update

During our English learning this week, we have started reading 'Beowulf by Michael Morporgo', where we have used the text to inspire our writing. The class have focused on how to use adjectives for description, how to include fronted adverbials and using punctuation for dialogue.

In Maths this week, the Yr 3/4 children have learnt the difference between a part and a whole, what the difference is between a unit fraction and non-unit fraction. Whereas the Yr 5/6 children have had a focus on multiplying and dividing fractions by fractions and whole numbers.

In Science this week, the Yr 3/4 children used sweets to replicate sedimentary rocks by cutting them up and making different colours layers. We then used tea lights to melt the sweets to show the change that can happen when rocks are heated. In Yr 5/6, the children learnt how different plants, vegetables and fruits reproduce – the children discussed the difference between pollination and fertilisation.

The focus for our P.E this half term with the Arena Coach has been Gymnastics, where the children have learnt how to balance, make shapes on the apparatus and link sequence of movements together. We have also had a focus of Netball, where the children have become more confident in attacking and defensive skills.
